Introduction

This study is the first of its kind; one which aims to answer the question, "How big is dodgeball?".

We thought it important to find the answer by examining three different areas; grass roots participation of dodgeball in the UK, the standard of our national teams from an elite sport perspective, and by examining our own organisation's social media reach.

We have compiled this report so we could help others better understand the current dodgeball landscape in order to facilitate further development and growth in the future. To discover the number of participants and where our national teams sit on the world stage, this report refers to a multitude of other organisations' studies, data and observations. We'd like to thank these organisations for gathering data on dodgeball. After examining the evidence contained in this report, we established ten key findings.

Key Findings

- Dodgeball is the second most participated team sport in schools and the fourth most
 participated team sport in the UK amongst young people (aged 5-16). 613,000 (8.7% of all the
 UK's 5-16 year olds) said they played it at least once to moderate intensity in the last week.

- 2. Approximately 1 in every 100 UK adults has played dodgeball at least once in the last year.

- 3. Approximately 1 in every 16 UK students has played dodgeball at least once in the last year.

- 4. Dodgeball is a young sport; 70% of adults that play regularly are aged 16-24 years old.

- 5. Dodgeball is the most in-demand sport in primary schools, with 1/3rd of all primary school children wanting to play more dodgeball above any other sport. Most schools that play dodgeball play once a week or more regularly.

- 6. Dodgeball is not yet a mainstream community club sport despite participation and demand figures from young people. An estimated 2,000 adults play weekly in British Dodgeball clubs, which is less than 5% of the total amount of active adult participants in the UK.

- 7. Dodgeball is one of the most popular School Games sports, with 10% of all county competitions taking place last year being dodgeball events.

Next Steps


Using our ten key findings, we have developed the following five next steps for British Dodgeball to take to develop the sport in the UK:

- School participation in dodgeball is extremely high. We will aim to standardise equipment across all schools that offer dodgeball in the UK. This will ensure a safe, enjoyable and consistent experience for participants. We will aim to standardise equipment by employing national-scale equipment partners.
- 2. We will aim to standardise rules and skill delivery across all schools that offer dodgeball in the UK. We will increase knowledge around the rules and the teaching of skills by offering teacher training, lesson plans and creating partnerships with delivery organisations that can assist us. We will set up a schools' competition pathway which works in conjunction with other organisations' national scale competition pathways.
- 3. Most active participants of dodgeball in the UK play informally. We will aim to create new clubs and develop existing clubs in order to increase the number of participants actively engaging in community club dodgeball. We will do this by securing funding for project work independently and in partnership with our existing community clubs and by attracting a partner to fund key regional activator roles.
- 4. Our national teams are some of the most successful in the world. We will maintain this standard by supporting our home nation teams. We will aim to develop a comprehensive talent pathway from junior players through to Team GB, identifying talented performers and developing them into world class athletes.
- 5. We will aim to increase our organisation's reach on social media. We will do this by creating partnerships with organisations that can help increase exposure to the grass root participation, the community club and the elite aspects of the sport. We will aim to host major international events regularly to further increase exposure to the elite side of the sport.

Findings

Young people:

- Overall: 613,000 young people actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 8.7% of all young people.
- Dodgeball is the 4th most highly participated team sport amongst all young people.
- 393,200 young people aged 5-11 actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 9.8% of all 5-11 year olds
- 220,700 young people aged 12-16 actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 7.7% of all 12-16 year olds.
- 7-11 year olds actively participate the most in dodgeball, with 337,800 participants. 12.8% of all 7-11 year olds actively participate in dodgeball.
- Participation ranking: Dodgeball is one of the most highly participated team sports by young people in the country, ranking between 2nd (amongst 5-6 year olds), 3rd (amongst 7-11 year olds), and 5th (amongst 12-16 year olds).
- **Key demographics:** 55% of all young people that actively participate in dodgeball are 7-11 years old. 73% of all young people that actively participate in dodgeball are 7-13 years old.

In schools:

- Overall: 521,800 young people actively participate in dodgeball in school, engaging 7.4% of all young people.
- Dodgeball is the 2nd most highly participated game in all schools.
- 326,700 primary school pupils actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 8.2% of all primary school pupils.
- 195,200 secondary school pupils actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 6.7% of all secondary school pupils.
- KS2 pupils actively participate the most in dodgeball, with 287,600 participants. 10.9% of all KS2 pupils actively participate in dodgeball.
- Participation Ranking: Dodgeball is one of the most highly participated school team sports in the country, ranking between 2nd (amongst KS1 pupils), 3rd (amongst KS2 pupils), 6th (amongst KS3 pupils) and 5th (amongst KS4 pupils).
- **Key demographics:** 55.1% of all young people that actively participate in dodgeball are in KS2. 37.4% of all young people that actively participate in dodgeball are in secondary school.


Outside of schools:

- Overall: 421,800 young people actively participate in dodgeball outside of school, engaging 6% of all young people.
- Dodgeball is the 4th most highly participated team sport outside of school.
- Dodgeball is the most highly participated team sport outside of school using an indoor venue, with 191,100 active participants (engaging 4.4% of all young people).
- 276,000 young people aged 5-11 actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 6.9% of all 5-11 year olds.
- 145,200 young people age 12-16 actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 5.1% of all 12-16 year olds.
- Participation Ranking: Dodgeball is one of the most highly participated team sports outside of school, ranking between 4th (amongst 5-6 year olds), 3rd (amongst 7-9 year olds), 4th (amongst 9-11 year olds), 6th (amongst 12-13 year olds) and 5th (amongst 14-16 year olds).
- **Key demographics:** 58.6% of all young people that participate in dodgeball outside of school are 7-11 years old. 76.9% of all young people that participate in dodgeball outside of school are 7-13 years old.

Findings

Overall:

- 52,400 people actively participate in dodgeball, engaging 0.1% of the UK's adult population.
- 424,700 people occasionally participate in dodgeball, engaging 0.9% of the UK's adult population.

Gender:

- 70.2% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are male (36,800), engaging 0.2% of the UK's entire male population.
- 29.8% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are female (15,600), engaging 0.1% of the UK's entire male population.
- 58.8% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are male (249,800), engaging 1.1% of the UK's entire male population.
- 41.2% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are female (174,900), engaging 0.8% of the UK's entire female population.

Age:

- 70.4% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are aged 16-24 (36,900), engaging 0.6% of the UK's entire 16-24 age demographic.
- 89.5% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are aged 16-34 (46,900), engaging 0.3% of the UK's entire 16-34 age demographic.
- 77.0% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are aged 16-24 (326,900), engaging 5.3% of the UK's entire 16-24 age demographic.
- 89.5% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are aged 16-34 (377,200), engaging 2.8% of the UK's entire 16-34 age demographic.

Education & Employment:

- 57.6% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are students or in post-16 education (30,200), engaging 0.7% of the entire student/post-16 education sector.
- 63.4% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are students or in post-16 education (269,100), engaging 6.3% of the entire student/post-16 education sector.
- 46.4% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are employed (24,300), engaging 0.1% of all employed UK adults.
- 28.6% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are employed (121,500), engaging 0.5% of all employed UK adults.


CLass:

- 41.6% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are classed as SC SEC9 (students/other) (21,800), engaging 0.6% of the UK's NS SEC9 (students/other) sector.
- 41.1% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are classed as SC SEC9 (students/other) (174,400), engaging 4.8% of the UK's NS SEC9 (students/other) sector.
- 24.2% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are classed as SC SEC1/2 (higher) (12,700), engaging 0.1% of the UK's SC SEC1/2 (higher) sector.
- 11.9% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are classed as SC SEC1/2 (higher) (50,600), engaging 0.4% of the UK's SC SEC1/2 (higher) sector.

- 70.6% of people that actively participate in dodgeball are white British (37,000), engaging 0.1% of the entire white British ethnicity.
- 9.6% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are black (40,700), engaging 2.9% of all UK black adults.
- 3.7% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are mixed (15,700), engaging 2.3% of all UK mixed adults.
- 12.4% of all people the occasionally participate in dodgeball are South Asian (52,600), engaging 1.8% of all UK South Asian adults.
- 69.8% of people that occasionally participate in dodgeball are white British (296,300), engaging 0.8% of the UK's entire white British ethnicity.

Ofsted Obesity, Healthy Eating and Physical Activity Research Article (Jul 18)

- Ofsted found dodgeball to be the most in-demand sport when children were asked the question, "What sport do you want to play more?", with 33% of children wanting to play more dodgeball. This beat football at 30%.
- Ofsted found dodgeball to be the $2^{\rm nd}$ most popular sport in primary schools, with 27% listing dodgeball as their favourite sport.
- Ofsted found that only 25% of schools were delivering dodgeball-related activity; this shows demand is there and there is room to grow and develop the sport.






Number of competitions and number of participants at School Games county events in 17/18 in different sports















- 91% of responding schools' pupils played dodgeball at least one per week.

- 72 schools replied to the survey. 6049 pupils played dodgeball at those schools.
















