FUNDING SUPPORT TERMS AND CONDITIONS



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Affiliated clubs and other organisations may access support from British Dodgeball staff members whilst in the process of applying for funding. This may include assistance sourcing relevant funding pots, bid-writing, project planning and administration, and general guidance. British Dodgeball offers this support to affiliated clubs and organisations with the understanding that the:

- Organisations involved have the necessary qualified workforce, safeguarding procedures and policies in place to properly undertake any planned projects.
- Organisations will adhere to all specific funding requirements, ensure project spend is in line with criteria listed on the successful application and will keep a detailed record of expenditure of funded items. To spend allocated funding on items not specified or to withhold expenditure of the funding is fraud and may result in clawback of funding or legal action being taken.
- Organisations will use British Dodgeball as the supplier for any services which British Dodgeball can provide. This includes, but is not limited to, equipment provision, education and training, criminal records checks, marketing, membership and competition entry.

British Dodgeball will not supply funding support without agreement to stick to these terms in writing from an appropriate representative of the organisation we are supporting. Any deviation from the above must be agreed with British Dodgeball in writing before funding support is given.

British Dodgeball is a non-profit organisation based in the U.K., where all income generated is invested into developing the sport of dodgeball. British Dodgeball does not charge clubs for funding support or charge a bid-writing fee, so it is important that British Dodgeball benefits by providing equipment and services to successfully funded projects in order to be able to continue to offer this service for member and non-member organisations.
