- To give timely feedback on matters involving breaches in regulation and ensure decisions are applied logically, fairly and consistently
- To 'lead from the front' in terms of demonstrating the highest standards of integrity at all times, including embodying the British Dodgeball Code of Conduct
- Champion the organisation's commitment to increasing diversity amongst participants in the sport and across our volunteer, staff and governance structures

Role Competencies:

The successful candidates will have a proven track record of effective communication in an organisation with multiple stakeholders. They will demonstrate knowledge of the British Dodgeball rules and regulations and have the ability to understand when they face a conflict of interest. They will show integrity in all aspects of their involvement with the sport. Prior experience within dodgeball is essential.

- 1. Commitment to British Dodgeball, its values, goals and ethics: Can form part of a high performing committee through values-based action
- 2. Understanding of the environment: Understanding the contribution dodgeball makes to society and to communities of players; have the ability to see the bigger picture when considering rules & regulations updates, and look beyond direct benefits to yourself and your own club
- 3. Highly developed communication skills: Excellent communication skills. Able to adapt communication and messages to a variety of audiences
- 4. Values-based behaviour: Displaying integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership
- 5. Strong critical thinking skills: Ability to analyse and assess information to make logical, consistent and fair decisions based upon factors including evidence, ethics, expertise and financial constraints
