Media Volunteers

We are looking for individuals who can document British Dodgeball events they attend to give exposure to these competitions. Volunteers do not need expensive equipment or training - a camera phone and willingness to take photos and short videos is enough. The footage you share will be used to promote the sport, supporting the growth of dodgeball in line with British Dodgeball's core vision:

"To inspire generations and communities to experience the benefits of playing dodgeball"

Role Details:

- This is a voluntary role.
- No defined term - continue as long as you are willing.
- Media Volunteer Time Commitment: Low - although more would be welcomed, sending just one or two photos from events you are attending is enough.
- Livestream Volunteer Time Commitment: Low - Volunteer at events which suit you. Matches last 25/45 minutes in total depending on the format of the event.
- Location: British Dodgeball Events

Media Volunteer Duties:

- Take the following kinds of photographs/footage:
 - Action Photos: Capture dynamic, high-energy action shots showcasing the intensity and teamwork during matches.
 - Team Photos: Take group photos to highlight team's emotions & celebrations.
 - Behind-the-scenes Moments: Capture candid shots of preparations, reactions, and interactions off the court.
 - Highlight from a Play: Short videos of remarkable plays which will be trimmed and shared for posting on TikTok and other platforms.
- Champion the organisation's commitment to increasing diversity amongst participants in the sport and across our volunteer, staff and governance structures by making efforts to focus on:
 - Women in Sport: Capture and share photos/videos highlighting the participation and achievements of women in dodgeball.
 - Come Join In: Capture and share photos/videos highlighting the participation and achievements of people of all ethnic backgrounds, socio-economic backgrounds and ages participating in our sport.
 - Workforce: Capture and share photos/videos of coaches, retrievers and referees to promote these roles alongside players.
